FEMALE

- **Ballet** - Any style black leotard and pink tights, hair in a bun
- **Contemporary & Jazz (all dancers)** - Neutral-colored form-flattering apparel that showcases the body in a professional way. NO loud colors or prints, or extra baggy clothing. If you feel it may be questioned, do not wear it. Hair pulled neatly off face.
- **Street Jazz & Hip Hop (all dancers)** - Clothes that bring your personality to life. Commercial/Industry classes are an opportunity to highlight your own identity. Street Shoe easy to move in is required.
- **Theatre Dance (females)** - Solid color top, leotard, crop top or tank with either tights, skirt or leggings. Nothing baggy. Character heels preferred but not mandatory.
- **All Other Classes (all dancers)** - Apparel that represents the best version of you. Hair pulled neatly off face unless otherwise noted. No sports bras or half tops, please.

MALE

- **Ballet** - Black tights, white or black form-fitting tank or tee
- **Contemporary & Jazz (all dancers)** - Neutral-colored form-flattering apparel that showcases the body in a professional way. NO loud colors or prints, or extra baggy clothing. If you feel it may be questioned, do not wear it. Hair pulled neatly off face.
- **Street Jazz & Hip Hop (all dancers)** - Clothes that bring your personality to life. Commercial/Industry classes are an opportunity to highlight your own identity. Street Shoe easy to move in is required.
- **Theatre Dance** - Solid color and form-fitting apparel. Hair pulled neatly off face.

Approximately 15 minutes

1. Walk to 2nd Avenue Subway Station (at 2nd Avenue and East Houston)
2. Take the **F** train Uptown towards Jamaica
3. Exit at West 4th Street
4. Head Northeast on 6th Avenue toward West 8th Street. The Joffrey Studios will be on your right side.

Directions from PACE to Joffrey Ballet School

Approximately 20 minutes

1. Walk to the Fulton Street Subway Station
2. Take the **A/C** Uptown
3. Exit at West 4th St.
4. Walk North, toward the tall clock. After you cross 9th Street, you'll see the Joffrey Studios.

Pearl Studios (500 8th Avenue)

Directions from East 3rd to Pearl Studios

Approximately 25 minutes

1. Walk to the 2nd Avenue F train stop
2. Take the **F** train uptown towards Jamaica 179th Street


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3. Get off at 34th Street- Herald Square
4. Head Northwest on W 35th Street towards 7th Ave/Fashion Avenue
5. Turn right onto 8th Avenue
6. Pearl will be on the right. The building "500" in large gold numbers

Directions from PACE to Pearl Studios



Approximately 25 minutes

1. Walk to the Fulton Street Subway Station
2. Take the  Uptown
3. Exit at 34th St, Penn Station
4. Walk 1 block, toward the Staples.
5. After 35th Street, you'll arrive at the glass doors with "500" printed in large gold numbers.

Joffrey Dance Center (47-10 Austell Pl, 4th floor)



Directions from East 3rd to Joffrey Dance Center

Approximately 35 minutes

1. Walk to the Astor Place Station (on Lafayette and East 8th Street)
2. Take the  train to Grand Central-42nd Street (5 stops)
3. At Grand Central, transfer to the Queens-bound  (towards Flushing-Main Street)
4. Exit at Hunters Point Ave
5. Walk East on 49th Ave, turn left on Skillman Ave.
6. Turn right on Austell Place, the address is 49-10 Austell Place

Directions from PACE to Joffrey Dance Center

Approximately 35 minutes

1. Walk to the Brooklyn Bridge-City Hall Subway station
2. Take the  Uptown
3. At 42nd St (Grand Central), transfer to the Queens-bound  (towards Flushing)
4. Exit at Hunters Point Ave
5. Walk East on 49th Ave, turn left on Skillman Ave.
6. Turn right on Austell Place
