Dress Code

FEMALE

Ballet: Black leotard, pink tights (*under the leotard and covering legs and feet completely*), pink ballet shoes. Warm up clothes must be removed before class starts. □

Contemporary: Dance shorts or pants, and fitted shirt.

MALE □

Ballet: Black tights, black or white t-shirt with black or white socks, and black or white ballet shoes.

Contemporary: Dance shorts or pants, and fitted shirt.

Rules

- Always wear your nametag on the front of your leotard or shirt (*very important so that faculty and staff can identify you*)
- Skirts can **only** be worn for pointe class
- No street shoes in the studio
- No food or drink in the studio
- No gum in class
- Cell phones should be turned off and put away during class
- If it isn't your dance bag, don't touch it or take it. We are not liable if your things are stolen.

- Follow the dress code
- If injured, must sit in chair and observe and take notes of class; be engaged and not on your phone

Directions from the Dorms to the Studios

Joffrey Ballet School (434 Avenue of the Americas, 3rd-5th Floors)


Directions from East 3rd to Joffrey Ballet School

Approximately 15 minutes

1. Walk to 2nd Avenue Subway Station (at 2nd Avenue and East Houston)
2. Take the  train Uptown towards Jamaica
3. Exit at West 4th Street
4. Head Northeast on 6th Avenue toward West 8th Street. The Joffrey Studios will be on your right side.

Directions from W 44th and 45th Street to Joffrey Ballet School

Approximately 20 minutes

1. Walk to the 42nd Street-Port Authority station on 42nd and 8th Avenue
2. Take the  Downtown (towards Rockaway Park)
3. Exit at W 4th Street- Washington Square
4. Walk Northeast on 6th Avenue towards W 8th street
5. Joffrey will be on the right, the address is 434 Avenue of the Americas, 3rd Floor
